You may qualify for one or more of the following programs offered by The Rinehart Clinic. Call 1-800-368-5182 to request more information.

THE SLIDING-FEE SCALE—For the uninsured or underinsured. This program, based on Federal Poverty Guidelines, determines the cost of your care by the size of your family and annual household income.

THE FAMILY PLANNING EXPANSION PROJECT (FPEP)—Funded by The US Department of Health and Human Services, this program is available to all US Citizens of reproductive age. If you qualify, FPEP will cover any costs related to annual exams, lab tests, contraceptives (including condoms), vasectomies, and preventative STD testing.

THE PRESCRIPTION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (PAP)—This much-needed program was founded in 2002 to help our patients pay for their prescription medications.

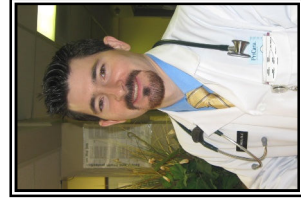
Meet Our Health Care Providers

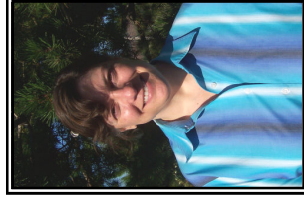
